2. 3. Transfer students admitted for the 2024-1 semester can register for courses only on the course registration date for all students, February 24, 2024.

【★ Precautions for Course Registration】

1. Your ID and password for course registration is the same as SAINT ID(student ID no.) and password.

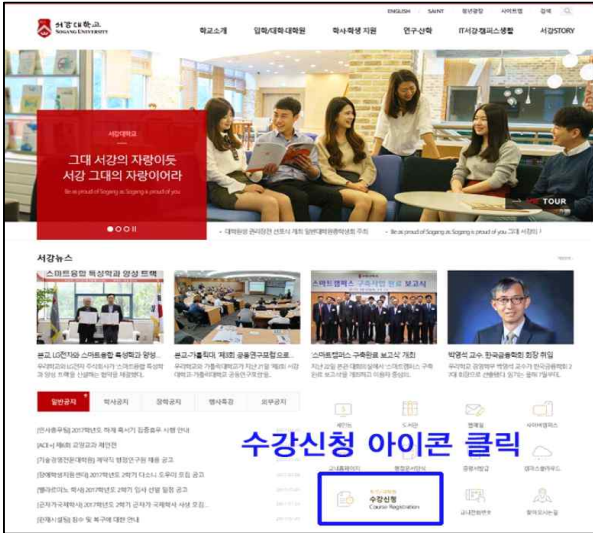
