\Rightarrow Summary:

- 1. All new students(freshmen) in 2024 Spring semester have to register on the day for the 1st year students [February 22nd 10:00 ~ 13:00]. If you don't complete your registration on that day, please register on the day for all students [February 24th 11:00~17:00]. You can register for courses online through the course registration website following the instructions below.
- 2. You can enroll in new courses or drop the course you have already registered for during the period to confirm and change registration [March 4th 08:00 ~ March 8th 17:00] through SAINT website and also by contacting your major administratin office after getting 'course permit', if you fail to register for courses during Course Registration period.
- 3. Transfer students admitted for the 2024-1 semester can register for courses only on the course registration date for all students, February 24, 2024.

I★ Precautions for Course Registration

- 1. Your ID and password for course registration is the same as SAINT ID(student ID no.) and password.
- 2. Before the registration period you have to change the password you were given. If you do not change it, then you will not be able to register for courses.
- 3. The period of course registration has been mentioned above. Only for that exact time and date, you can log in the page and register for the courses.
- **4**. You must access the offered course details section and check the information such as 'subject description', 'note', 'semester available for completion', 'international students only class', and 'English lecture' for each subject before registering for the course.
- 5. You have to apply for at least 9 credits per semester. You may be subject to a forced leave of absence if you apply for less than 9 credits.
- * International students admitted to Sogang University are exempt from the Sogang University school rule that 'all students must complete English major courses offered in English before graduation.' Even if you do not complete English major courses, you can graduate if other graduation requirements are met.




⑤ Security code can be entered in both lower/upper cases.

If you enter the security code correctly, the tabs below will become activated by pressing the enter key.

Put the number and session of the desired courses together (ex. ABC1004-01) and then click "save."



① Message will pop up if the security code has been incorrectly entered. Please make sure to enter the security code correctly less than 5 tries. If the incorrect code gets entered for 5 consecutive tries, the system gets disabled for 5 minutes.



9 If students use detailed course info tab and search a subject with keywords, there is no need to enter a security code above.



- 6 Screen after "save" (A new security code needed in order to proceed again)
- The entered course numbers will be applied to the system upon saving. (If the course quota limit has been reached, or if the student has registered for an ineligible course due to different major or year requirement, the entered course will be rejected.) Students can check whether or not the entered courses have been applied to the registration system on the section below.
- After the system has been updated, the process resets and students must enter a new security code in order to proceed again.
- If the course number has been incorrectly entered, student must enter a new security code.



 Another message will pop up if the security code has been incorrectly entered for five consecutive tries. The registration system will be restricted for the next 5 minutes and the available time will be shown on the bottom page of the message.



** After course registration, you must click LOGOUT, and close all open browsers.

If you close the course registration website by force (by pressing "x"), there might be a problem of multiple logins. (In this case, your course registration may not be effective.)
