General Education courses : Core requisite, Core elective, General elective, Major introductory courses	
Core requisite	Students must take 1 course in each detailed division.
Core elective	Students must take 1 course each from 2 different detailed divisions out of 4 detailed divisions other than 'Korean Culture'. All 2 courses in 'Korean Culture' detailed division are also required to take.
General elective	Students can take any courses from general elective courses freely. Students are also allowed to take major requisite of other majors (with the exception of few majors such as BA) and credits earned through such courses will be counted toward elective credits.
Major introductory	Major introductory courses are required courses designated by the department/major that are designed to build fundamental knowledge necessary for each major and credits will be counted toward elective credits.

Major courses : Required Major, Elective Major courses
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Major courses are divided into Required Major and Elective Major course. In most cases, students are allowed to take major courses starting from their 2nd academic year. Required Major courses must be completed in order to successfully graduate while Elective Major courses can be freely chosen on students' course planning.

Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 'Korean Writing for foreign students' course is for International students. - Students with advanced Korean level can choose either '인문사회글쓰기' or '자연계글쓰기' according to their major.
Global Language1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - International students cannot take their mother tongue language course. - A Freshman in School of Humanities and School of Social Sciences must take the same language course in "Global Language 2" as they chose in "Global Language 1" to fulfill the Major Basics requirement. Ex) If you have completed '글로벌 의사소통1', you must take '글로벌 의사소통 2' on the "Introduction to Major" division (Only for Humanities or Social Sciences students)
Computational Thinking	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Many international students have struggled through this subject so far. - Although there are International students-only classes including assistants, it is highly recommended taking this course after one's level of Korean is considerably improved. - Available semester may vary according to one's major.
Albatross Seminar	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Introduction of Major and College life, and networking with other freshmen/women and Professors will take place during this course. - No credit limit on course registration (will be counted toward credits required for graduation) - Administration office of each major will register for the course and then notify the students of each one's class number via e-mail or text. Make sure to follow up the notices and attend the class accordingly. - Must take this course in your very first semester!

★★ Please check the details of Core requisite courses and refer to the notes on the 'Courses Offered Info'.

★ Please check the availability of taking courses according to one's major and/or department.

★ Please check whether the course is 'only for international students' or 'English-speaking'.

★ You must take a minimum of 9 credits in each semester.

	- Select one course each from 2 detailed divisions out of 4 divisions, '인간과 신앙' (① Human and Religion), '인간과 사상' (② Human and Philosophy), '인간과 사회' (③ Human and Society), '인간과 과학' (④ Human and Science)
	- All Freshmen from School of Natural Science and Engineering must select Calculus I (미적분학 I) in '인간과 과학(Human and Science)' detailed division.
	- There are classes 'only for international students', 'only for chinese students', and 'English-speaking' in Core Requisites, Core electives.
	- For General Electives, it is recommended that students choose subjects they are interested in or courses about languages and cultures they are interested in.

【★ Notice on course registration】

- ① All new students(freshmen) in 2020 2nd semester have to register on the day for the 1st years [AUGUST 10(MON.) 11AM~5PM]. If you don't complete your registration on that day, please register on the day for everyone[AUGUST 19(WED.) 11AM~5PM]. You can register for courses online through the course registration website following the instructions below.
- ② You can enroll in new courses or drop the course you have already registered for during the period to confirm and change course registration[SEPTEMBER 2(WED.) 8AM ~ SEPTEMBER 7(MON.) 5PM] through SAINT website and also by contacting your major administrative office after getting permission, if you fail to register for courses during Course Registration period.

【★ Precautions for Course Registration】

1. Make sure to click the [Log out] button when you leave the course registraion page.
2. The period of course registration has been mentioned above. Only for that exact time and date, you can log in the page and register for the courses.
3. Your ID and password for course registration is the same as SAINT ID(student ID no.) and password. You must check your ID and password in advance.

【★ Korean Level Test for Sogang International Students】

It is the most helpful way for international students to adapt to Sogang educational program and take university education when students get advised on course planning according to their Korean Proficiency results.

- Subject and the Date of examination : “Mandatory for Freshmen Students”, Details will be announced soon on another announcement.**

- * There is no Korean Level Test for transfer students.
- * If you don't take the Level Test, you can be at a disadvantage in the Fall semester.

2) How to check Course Details, List of Courses Completed, Major Courses

(1) Course Details

Students can find detailed information about course, including class time, classroom, academic session, course syllabus, etc on “Course Offered Info” webpage.

Sogang University website → 「Undergraduate Schools」 → 「Course Details」

(2) List of Courses Completed

Students can check what courses they have completed so far and have to complete in the future on “List of Courses Completed”.

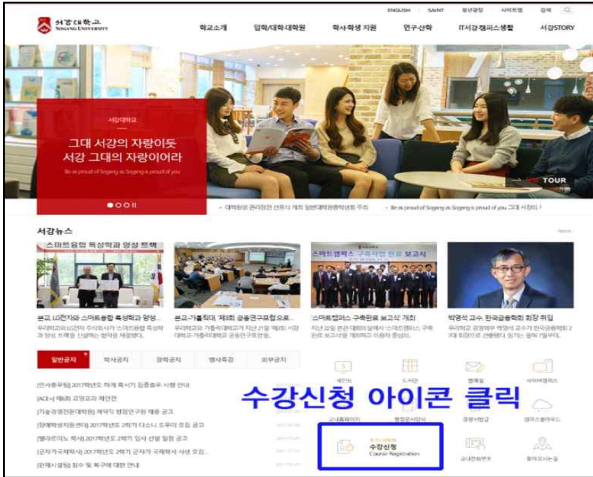
Log in to SAINT(<http://saint.sogang.ac.kr/>) → Select “Courses/Grades” → Select “Courses Completed (UG)” → Orange dots appear on completed courses.

(3) Major Courses

Log in to SAINT portal(<http://saint.sogang.ac.kr/>) → Select “Graduation” → Select “Inquiry of Graduation Requirements” → Select position, major, and standard academic year, then click “Inquiry” (refer to the sample image attached)

3) Course Registration Instructions

① Click "Course Registration" banner under Sogang University Korean homepage.



② Log-in with your student ID and password on the registration page.



③ Course Registration Webpage

- "Personal Course Schedule": Students can check listed course schedule sorted by days
- "Log-out": Once course registration is completed, select log-out to protect personal information, then close all browser.



④ Input security code first.



⑤ Security code can be entered in both lower/upper cases.

If you enter the security code correctly, the tabs below will become activated by pressing the enter key.

Put the number and session of the desired courses together (ex. ABC1004-01) and then click "save."

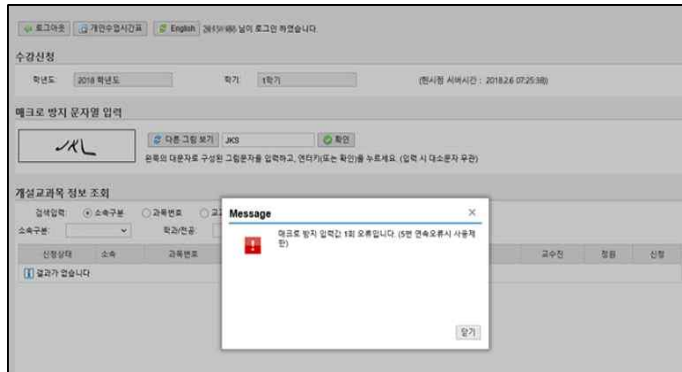


⑥ Upon saving, should the students desire entering the new course number, the security code must be entered again.

- The entered course numbers will be applied to the system upon saving. (If the course quota limit has been reached, or if the student has registered for an ineligible course due to different major or year requirement, the entered course will be rejected.) Students can check whether or not the entered courses have been applied to the registration system on the section below.
- After the system has been updated, the process resets and students must enter a new security code in order to proceed again.
- If the course number has been incorrectly entered, student must enter a new security code.



⑦ Message will pop up if the security code has been incorrectly entered. Please make sure to enter the security code correctly less than 5 tries. If the incorrect code gets entered for 5 consecutive tries, the system gets disabled for 5 minutes.



⑧ Another message will pop up if the security code has been incorrectly entered for five consecutive tries. The registration system will be restricted for the next 5 minutes and the available time will be shown on the bottom page of the message.



⑨ If students use detailed course info tab, there is no need to enter a security code above.



**** After course registration, you must click LOGOUT, and close all open browsers.**

If you close the course registration website by force (by pressing "x"), there might be a problem of multiple logins. (In this case, your course registration may not be effective.)

4) Course Registration Instructions for Freshman International Students

(1) Korean level/TOPIK level 3/IELTS(Eng.)

(required to take mandatory Korean Language Course at KLEC)

- ① You must take the Korean language curriculum at the Korean Language Center in addition to your university courses
- ② The method of registering for these Korean language courses is different from registering for regular courses in the university
- ③ How to register for the Korean language curriculum
 - ⓐ Mandatory Korean language courses from Monday to Friday every week from 13:30 to 17:30 at the KLEC (6 credits)
 - ⓑ Registration period for the Korean courses
 - (1st period) Tuesday, July 14th 2020 ~ Friday, August 7th
 - (2nd period to register and cancel) Monday, August 10th ~ Friday, August 21st
 - Education Center for International Students will register for your Korean language courses after your course registration period is over.
 - You will receive 6 credits after you get your score from KLEC.

- ④ How to register for courses in the department
 - ⓐ Credit limit for course registration: maximum 10 credits

 - September 2nd 8:00 ~ 7th 17:00 (Course registration change period)
 - ⓒ Course Registration: Register for the courses directly



(2) Korean level/TOPIK level 4 or above

- ① No particular credit limit for course registration (register up to 19 credits)
- ② Course registration period
 - August 10th 2020 11:00~17:00 (for Freshmen)
 - August 20th 2020 11:00~17:00 (for all academic years)
 - September 2nd 8:00 ~ 7th 17:00 (Course registration change period)
- ③ Course Registration: Register for the courses directly

(3) Students who applied for the 'Korean Society and Culture' major
